Although Al uses a computer/communication aid (a well-spoken English accent) - she has an inner voice (a Scouse accent) that says exactly what she is thinking and can belt out any song she thinks of. No one else can hear this, apart from the audience and the people closest to her, who already know what she is thinking.

"Everybody's BITCHIN' about AL" fills a massive void in the theatre world. It's an honest, funny, and powerful show that provides a genuine insight into the lives of people with severe disabilities - a concept that is extremely rare. I believe it is crucial for a severely disabled actress to play the leading role, ensuring the story is told with the authenticity it deserves.

The original songs will enhance the overall story and help the audience connect with the characters on a deeper, more personal level. This musical is a powerful statement about changing perceptions and celebrating diversity. It will appeal to seasoned theatregoers and a wider audience looking for a truly unique and entertaining night out.
